The word “kairos” is from the Greek language and is described by Merriam-Webster as *“a time when conditions are right for the accomplishment of crucial action; the opportune and decisive moment.”* The Greek definition is a little more theological and personal... *“God’s special moment.”*

We’re sure you have heard mention of the Kairos Ministry around our Emmaus and Chrysalis camps. **Kairos is a prison ministry similar to the weekends we attended as pilgrims and caterpillars.** Our local Kairos Ministry holds weekends inside the Northeast Tennessee Correctional Complex in Mountain City for inmates who would like to participate, as well as outside events for the wives, mothers, daughters, and other female family members affected by the incarceration of a loved one. **These weekends are designed to be God’s special moment in the lives of the inmates and their family in the midst of a season of struggle.**
